Lesson 3 The Dotted Half Note

When a dot is added after a note, the value or length of the note is increased by half. Remember the half note is equal to two beats. When it is followed by a dot, it is called a dotted half note and is now equal to three beats.

Check Point - Note Values

1. Quarter note = one beat.
2. Half note = two beats.
3. Dotted half note = three beats.
4. Whole note = four beats.
